



## GUIDELINES

### PAUL PAVLUS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Paul Pavlus Scholarship Award will be given to a deserving graduating senior, or anyone participating in a continuing educational program such as college, trade school or vocational school, and who has been attending the Lyonsville Congregational Church on a regular basis for a minimum of two years.

The criteria for selection of the scholarship is based on what Mr. Pavlus believed to be the essential qualities of one's character.

1. **Leadership:** including such qualities as dependability, honesty and extra effort.
2. **Patriotism:** including loyalty to American ideals and concern for others.
3. **Service:** including the ability to accept responsibility.
4. **Academic Achievement:** including a genuine desire to further one's education.
5. **Service to the Church:** includes membership in Lyonsville church and at least 2 years of regular attendance.

The selection committee will meet to determine what award, if any, shall be made on an annual basis. The committee members include the Chairperson of the Religious Education Ministry Board; a member from the Leadership Council; a member from the Evangelism Ministry Board and the Pastor. In addition to the written application, the applicant will be required to meet with the selection committee.

The scholarship is a **one time** award and as such is not renewable.

Be certain to obtain an application from the Church office and return the completed form by **September 17, 2017**. The selection committee will contact all candidates to schedule an interview.
